Keeping Safe & Warm

Electric blankets can be a great way to get some extra warmth as long as you remember to use them safely and correctly. To minimize the potential for fire or injury, choose and inspect your electric blanket carefully by following these tips:

1. Verify that your blanket has been tested and approved by an independent safety agency.
2. If the blanket is torn, has a damaged control or frayed cord, or is more than 10 years old, replace it with a new one.
3. If you see any spots that are dark or appear to be burn marks, or if it appears that wires inside the blanket have moved out of position or have broken, replace it.
4. Always follow the manufacturer's recommendations for care of your electric blanket. Machine washing your blanket can cause agitation and damage the wire inside.
5. When you store an electric blanket, either roll it carefully or try to minimize the number of folds so you don't damage the internal wiring.

Upgrade your appliances and add a DRU switch to earn rebates.

Henry County REMC has rebates for members who purchase high efficiency heating, cooling or water heating equipment. (See equipment specifications below.) To support its Energy Management Program, REMC will install a switch on all new appliances for free before issuing rebate checks.

These switches are used to turn off the elements of water heaters or to cycle air conditioners or heat pumps on and off. This only occurs on the hottest days of summer and the coldest days of winter to reduce power demand during peak times.

The rates that REMC pays are higher during these peak periods. If we can reduce demand, we can reduce wholesale power costs. More than 70 percent of REMC's expenses are for wholesale power. We can make a larger impact on our rates by getting more participation in this program.

Members participating in the program will receive up to \$18 per year in incentives for each appliance under control. Visit HenryCountyREMC.com for details.
